 document following enquiries into SU1's Objs TYBURN (15 Feb 11) and Obj 9  
 (13 Mar 11).Â It should be read in full.

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A TPE raise concerns with  
 TTPs that were used by SU1 at the time, specifically the use of occupants to  
 help clear a compound. Specific points raised include:

- \* Concern that SU1 put  
 these individuals at additional risk whilst they were under ISAF  
 protection.

- \* Scepticism about the  
 willingness of the occupants.

- \* Interest in further  
 dialogue with "UK authorities" on this and related matters linked to Afghan  
 casualties.

Finally a TPE request  
 a review of UK TTPs, which has already occurred (twice) since these events.  
 Furthermore the imminent review of the Night Raids Directive may impose further  
 changes to SFHQ(A) TTPs that would mitigate many of a TPE's  
 concerns.

At the start of the meeting, A TPE handed over two copies of a written document which will be sent to SFHQ(A) by SFHQ(A) LNO a scan is attached.

The document is based on a a practice of using occupants that had obeyed calls to leave compounds to then return into the compounds to ensure all people had exited or to open doors and windows. A TPE were unaware of this practice prior to the meeting on DG May. The document refers to a specific occasion on 15 Feb 2011(Obj TYBURN) and 13 Mar 2011(not Known) a TPE have expressed a number of concerns regarding this practice

Name Given explained the cultural sensitivities regarding Afghan compounds and stated that the practice was intended to reduce the danger of civilian casualties, not reduce the danger to military personnel. A TPE position being, if two of the individuals killed in the operation on 15 Feb had not been taken back into the compound they would not have been able to pose further threat.

There were some general questions asked on UK ROE, the Tactical Directive, Night Raid Directive, National caveats and Detention chains, during which a TPE aired a belief that the UK SOF tended to have a high rate of kills on "Capture/Kill" missions. The point was made that the UK conduct detention operations, not Capture/kill and the figures were disputed.

The overall tone of the meeting was relaxed and friendly.
