Attached is the SFHQ(A) ISAF 2 LO report on a TPE meeting today along with a TPE written document following enquiries into SU1's Objs TYBURN (15 Feb 11) and Obj 9 (13 Mar 11). It should be read in full.

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A TPE raise concerns with TTPs that were used by SU1 at the time, specifically the use of occupants to help clear a compound. Specific points raised include:

- * Concern that SU1 put these individuals at additional risk whilst they were under ISAF protection.
- * Scepticism about the willingness of the occupants.
- * Interest in further dialogue with "UK authorities" on this and related matters linked to Afghan casualties.

Finally a TPE request a review of UK TTPs, which has already occurred (twice) since these events. Furthermore the imminent review of the Night Raids Directive may impose further changes to SFHQ(A) TTPs that would mitigate many of a TPE's concerns.
