accompanied by Sgt Roberts E, of my unit. Also in attendance was SO1 Legal, DSF.

Purpose of visit was to ascertain if N1803 had knowledge of the TTP review / Mohammad Bang incident and her involvement in the process (pre/during/after).

N1803 confirmed she was head of policy within DSF at the time / also had a role in disclosure. Responsible to

liaise with mod and ensure ministerial approval for all new operations in conjunction with the relevant legal authorities. N1803 would routinely scan snippets from ops - not only theatre but rest of world. This was busy period [redacted]

LG (not A) Operational Detail

[redacted], however noticed a tactic whereby individuals were detained then brought back into buildings which resulted in fatalities. N1803 not on scene in tactics but had not encountered this and questioned it. Spoke to SO1 Campaigns and ACAS Ops and decision reached that the Director should be informed. N1803 did not personally speak with Director on this matter nor did she see final product.

Due to the time elapsed since the incident (circa 5 years) N1803 asked if she could review some material (if the investigation team already had it) to refresh her memory. I informed N1803 that 'Best practice' is to record her evidence as she could recall, cognisant of the time elapsed however I would consult the SIO on his opinion

reference this COA. N1803 was informed she was covered by the DSF protocol and anonymity would be utilised via the use of ciphers.

The meeting ended with N1803 agreeing to provide a witness statement.

Sgt Roberts will correspond with N1803 with tentative dates for the aforementioned appointment and once agreed by all parties the statement will be recorded in a suitable location.

N1803 is currently not at work and is due to return to work Date Given. The statement will be recorded in the next few weeks.
