TEAM 1 SIO (N50) POLICY DECISION 27 - INTERVIEW OF SAITULLAH

Policy Text

Decision:

Correspondence received from GOLD originating from TSOL indicating that LDC (Leigh Day and Company) were now representing SAITULLAH, the teenage relative of Mohammed BANG who has been present during the operation in which Mr BANG was detained and the 4 men were killed.

This person has not previously come to our attention as a complainant. Measures will need to be instigated to interview him as a witness talking into account his age, vulnerability and the significance of the evidence he will provide.

He is to be prioritised in a similar manner to Mohammed BANG with LDC being requested to provide further detail and direct correspondence to RMP as opposed to communicating via TSOL on this matter.

Reason:

SAITULLAH is a potential significant witness in this case and can provide evidence in relation to the investigation.

He is to be prioritised in terms of interviewing as a witness taking account of his status and age. By LDC corresponding with TSOL, this is frustrating our progress as this causes a delay in informing us of relevant information. Team 2 will need to incorporate planning to interview this witness.
