Policy Text	SCENE IDENTIFICATION-UNLAWFUL KILLING

### Decision:

The complainant has alleged that when detained at his home address his family members were unlawfully killed. The scenes of the alleged offences are to be identified in evidence. Where possible, the scene is to be visited. Should this not be possible, evidence detailing why is to be recorded and a reconstruction of the scene is to be considered either in some physical form or by means of full motion video, photography, satellite imagery or geo-mapping.

### Reason:

The scene of the offence under report is key to understanding what allegedly took place. The alleged offences took place over 3 years ago and the security situation in Helmand Province is fragile. In all likelihood, it will not be possible for RMP to visit the scene. If this is the case, evidence detailing why this is not possible will demonstrate the rationale for not doing so. Scene reconstruction through available and historic resources may be the only option available whether utilising ISTAR assets or conventional mapping. Accurate scene representation will be beneficial for investigative purposes in order to allow investigators, witnesses, suspects and any future participants in any subsequent disciplinary proceedings gain an understanding of what the ground, area and location was like at the material time of the alleged offences.
