TEAM 1 SIO (N50) POLICY DECISION 16 - HOUSE TO HOUSE (H2H)

Policy Text

Decision:

House to House (H2H) enquiries are not conducive to AFG, however alternate methods of appealing for witnesses are to be considered. Where H2H enquiries are discounted evidence is to be recorded in determining this decision, ie the current J2 picture. Other methods may include engagement with local religions / community leaders / local AFG police, NGO's, [REDACTED] and other recognised intermediaries, whether in person or utilising other methods eg - leaflet drops, posters etc. A H2H coordinator is to be appointed (Sgt SMITH).

Reason:

There are very few known witnesses to the incident under report, H2H enquiries have the potential to identify witnesses living/working within the locations relevant to the incident. Due to the volatile security situation and the potential lack of FP in a hostile environment, it is appropriate that the intelligence picture be assessed to deem whether it is proportionate to conduct physical H2H enquiries. Other partners can be engaged to assist and help to enlist the support of the local community. The use of leaflets, posters or other non verbal communications may assist due to the security situation and language barrier. Local relations with British or Coalition partners may not be good and the use of NGO's and non state actors may prove useful in engaging with the local community which may contain key witnesses. The J2 picture will potentially illustrate why the RMP were not able to achieve too much as we would like.
